Authors will be informed about the acceptance of their submission by early February. This year's participation fee for accepted participants will be 70 euros. Participants will have to cover their expenses for travel and accommodation. We hope to be able to hold the conference in person, but if the pandemic makes that impossible, we will hold a fully online conference instead. A prize for the best paper will be awarded during the conference.
